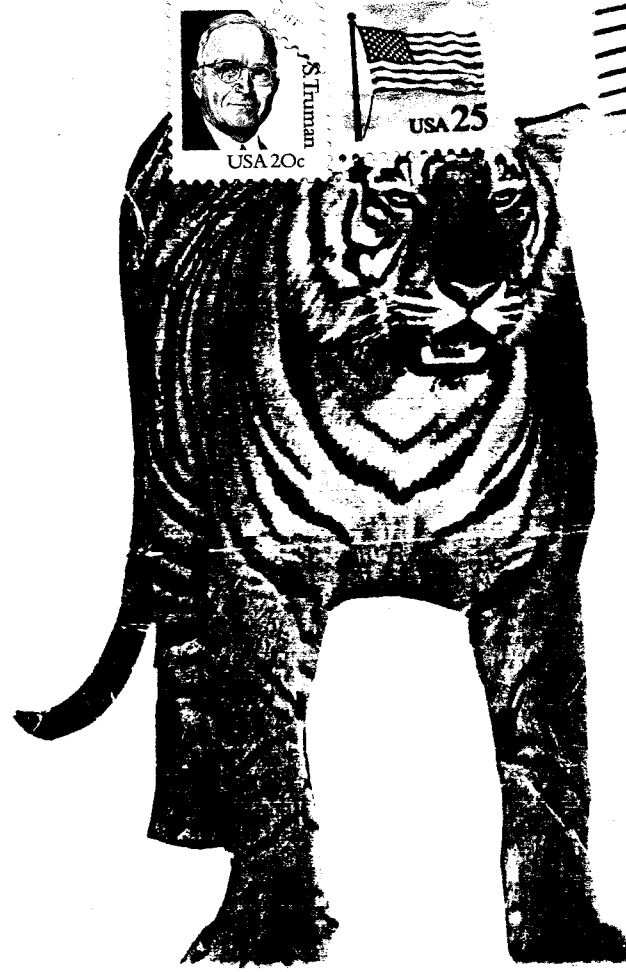
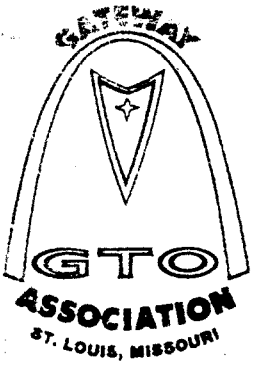

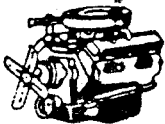

2ND ANNUAL MUSCLE CAR SHOOTOUT MAY 6-7 AT ST. LOUIS INTERNATIONAL RACEWAY

In May of 1988 Len Greco put on the 1st annual muscle car shootout. The G.T.O. being the original muscle car was there to be reckoned with, but fate saw it different. The new kid on the block (Buick Grand National) took 5 of 6 top spots in the muscle vs. high tech class, that was 1988 the Gateway G.T.O.'s has a year to plan a revenge.

Tony Bezzole, Rich Vie, Will Bower, and Ron Beach brought fame back to the Pontiac G.T.O muscle cars as well as fortune for themselves by taking 4 of the 6 top spots in the 1989 muscle car shootout vs. high tech which was held Sunday May 6-7 at St. Louis International Raceway. There was 57 cars in this class.

Former club member Ron Beach took First in his 1965-428 Red G.T.O. Tony Bezzole, our treasurer took Second with his 1970 Red & Black 462 Ram Air G.T.O., Rich Vie, President of the Gateway G.T.O. Club, took Fourth Place with his 1971 TA 455. Will Bower took Sixth Place with his 1965 Red G.T.O. The four veteran racers virtually shut down The Grand Nationals who had dominated the 1988 races and re-established the muscle car that the Pontiac G.T.O. is known for. The winners were heard to have said that it was "no problem"! As they left the event at the end of the day, Craig Weiss had some bad luck with his 65 G.T.O. when he broke an axle on his first run. In the car show John Rolfes won Second in the 55-70 restored class. He has a 67 G.T.O. William Skeens took Third in the restored muscle car 57-73 class. He has a 67 G.T.O. convertible in the mild custom class. G.T.O.'s took the top 3 spots with members Kevin Frigerio's 69 G.T.O. taking a Second Place. Dave Kries 68 convertible won First Place and best under carriage of the show's.

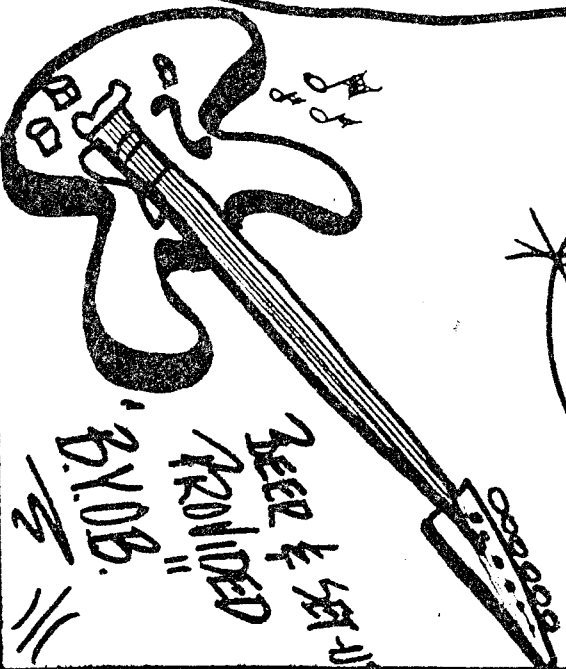
