As you all know our Nationals took place June 22, 1994, approximately 4 months ago. A great time was had by everyone, unfortunately there is still some business that needs to be taken care of. For those of you not at our last meeting, I will try to fill you in.

The Gateway GTO Association pushed for spectator attendance at the track for The Day at The Track. The GTO National Association (GTOAA) granted us permission to allow spectators to attend. For the first time (to our knowledge) the Day at the Track was open for spectator attendance. There was a separate fee of \$20.00 per car for the spectators, with 50% of the proceeds going to a charitable organization of our choice and the other 50% going to the GTO National Association. The Gateway GTO Association chose a local children's charity, The Dream Factory. The Dream Factory uses 97% of the money it receive to grant terminally ill children a wish.

The spectator Gate took in approximately \$3,000.00. We were told that some money was taken off the top to pay <u>something</u>, but that the Dream Factory would receive \$1,300.00. Well no one quite understands why the Dream Factory hadn't been paid as of Oct. 6. We were told that the GTO National bank account here in St. Louis, was waiting on money from the GTO National Association (GTOAA), and that there were a number of other bills yet to be paid. Our Gateway GTO Club all agreed that the Dream Factory should have been paid before now. So rather than wait any longer the local GTO National treasurer, Cathey Pacelli and myself suggested that the Gateway GTO Association pay the \$1,300.00 to the Dream Factory. Cathey assured us that the GTO National Association (GTOAA) would reimburse the Gateway Club.

So on Monday, Oct. 10, 1994, I presented the Dream Factory with their check of \$1,300.00. The Dream Factory sends their thanks and deeply appreciates our efforts. I would also like to thank the Gateway GTO Association for seeing that the Dream Factory received their money.


