Our Members this year equal 78 with 43 belonging to GTOAA also. Our new members this month are, Tom & Marilyn Blancett. Welcome!

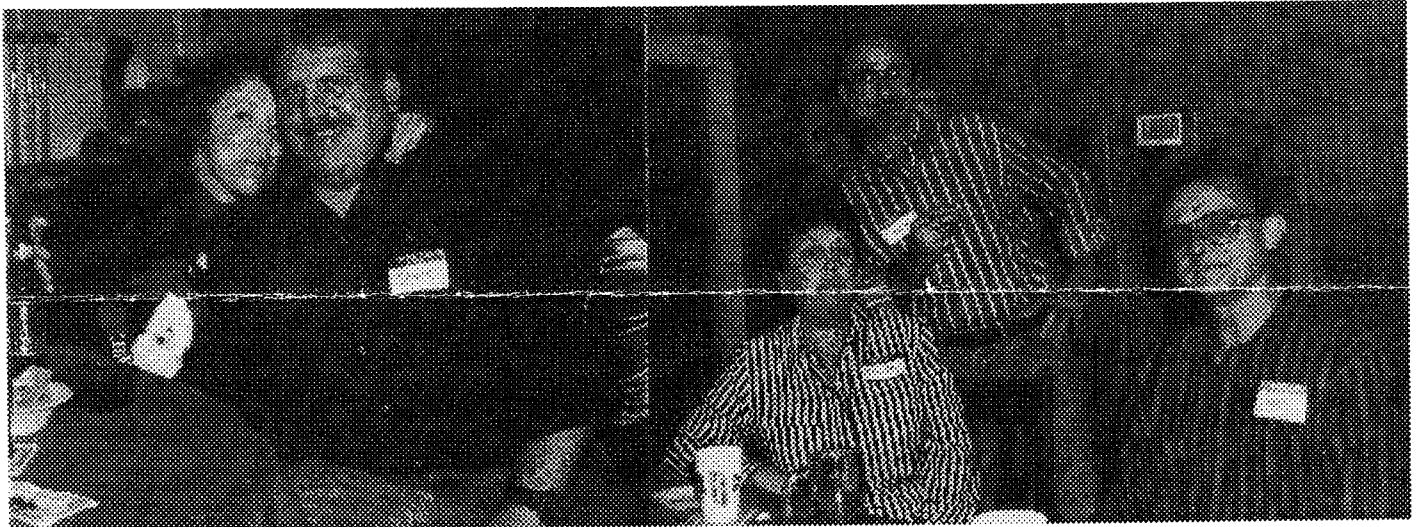
