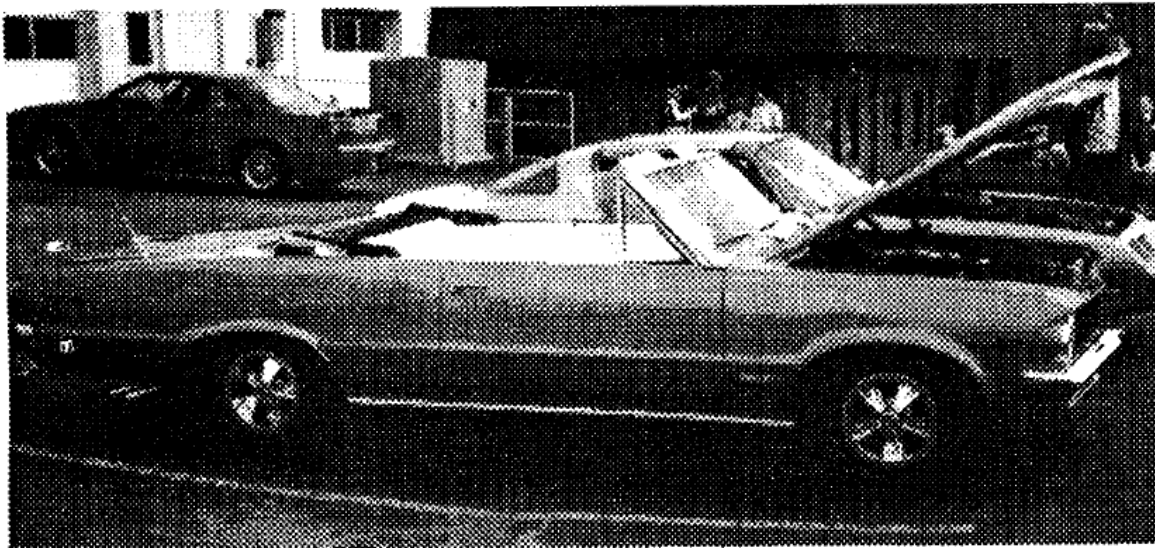
## **DON DARR CAR SHOW, 4/22/95**

## AMERICAN ROADHOUSE

The cruise at The American Roadhouse is just about 2 months away once you receive this newsletter. As was previously reported, we, as a club, are the 'HOST' club on June 10th. I have attended almost every cruise at The Roadhouse since moving to Missouri two years ago. About 100 cars or more attend on the 2nd Saturday of each month, April through September. It would be great if we had a large showing. The Roadhouse has an adjoining parking lot that holds about 50 or more cars. The overflow is parked across the street in a bank's parking lot that holds more than that. I need to know who and how many cars to expect so we can reserve these choice spaces in the main parking lot. Although they would like us to be there by 3:45 p.m., they will allow me to reserve a few spots if someone cannot possibly make it by that time. If you have to work late or if you must come late, I can hold spots for you but it will be limited. Please phone me at least one week in advance, that is by June 3rd to let me know you'll be there. I have also contacted the Arch Chapter POCI and they will run this in their 'events' calendar. The more cars the better. The food is excellent, if you like burgers 'n' stuff. Remember, if you don't call me and show up late, you will be put in the parking lot across the street (if there is room). I hope we get a lot of participation. If we do and we like what it was about, we might get another shot at being the 'HOST' at a later date. The Roadhouse is at 1215 S. Duchesne, St. Charles, MO. or phone Marty Howard at 946-8641.

In addition to the Roadhouse cruise, I've gotten wind of another event that sounds really interesting. It is a combination of parade, cruise and show. It is called The Jenningsfest Parade. - \* Cars will be displayed/judged at Koeneman Park in Jennings
- \* Entry forms will be forthcoming

# GGTOA PARTICIPATION POINTS SYSTEM

## Point System Rules

1. Attendance at GGTOA sponsored or GGTOA participation events:
  - a. To receive the maximum points for event, members/associates must participate with their GTO, LeMans or Tempest
  - c. If a member brings one GTO and their associate brings a second the max. points plus half the max. will be awarded
  - d. If one member drives another member's GTO to an event, the owner receives the max. and the driver half the max.
  - e. For any other situations the decision will be at the discretion of the officers
2. Members / Associates shall be responsible for signing the Official attendance sheet at all GGTOA Sponsored / Participation Events. You must sign in to get points!
3. Points shall be awarded only once per event if event last more that one day
4. Members / Associates must be able to provide proof of participation in any non club event (entry form, dash plaque, race slip, etc.) or vouched for by another member.
5. Members / Associates shall be have one month to inform the score keeper of their participation in any non club event.
6. Points shall be tallied from January 1st through November with awards being presented at the Christmas party.
