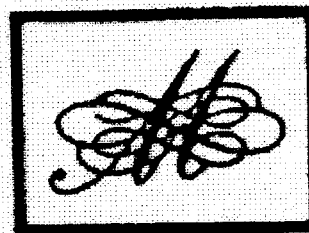

The NMCA meet will be this weekend at Gateway International (May 4 &5).

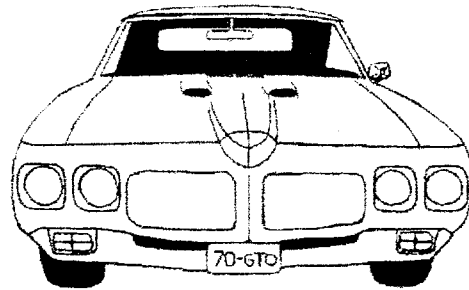

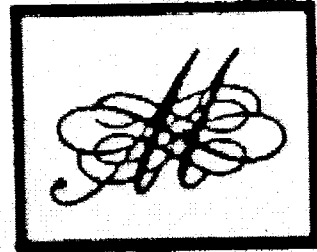

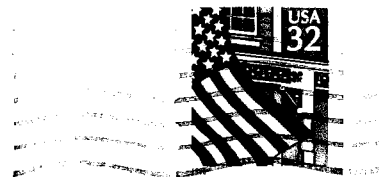
